2015 Highlights

Who You Have Helped:

Direct Shelter Services



562 adults and children (unduplicated) found shelter and services through EUMA programs. This includes:

- * 187 children (that means we cared for 86% of all children in Erie's emergency homeless shelter system)
- * 96 families were kept together during their time of homelessness (64% of all homeless families in Erie County)
- * 49 veterans (32% of all Veterans in Erie's homeless shelter system)

Total Bednights



A total of 16,517 bednights were supplied to end immediate homelessness.

Positive Outcomes



77% of families and 82% of Veterans moved to permanent housing.

Voucher Assistance



- * 1,146 adults and 723 children benefited from the voucher assistance program at The Rainbow Connection Thrift Store.
- * That equates to \$39,544.10 worth of clothing and household items distributed for free to those in need.

Healthcare for the Homeless



EUMA's most recent program addition, Healthcare for the Homeless Partnership, began in late 2014 to ensure that homeless individuals and families receive proper medical care. 241 homeless patients were screened, cared for, and referred to appropriate medical providers, 92 of whom were not known to have health insurance.






