**Ending Homelessness for Veterans** 

Richard Dinch's Journey from Hopelessness to Hope.

Richard was raised in a small town near Bradford, PA. He shared that he was a troubled kid, often the target of his father's anger and abuse. When he was 17 – he was caught smoking at school, stole a truck from a neighbor, and ended up going to jail. One day when he came home from school a military recruiter was at his house. He felt like the only choice he had at the time was to enlist into the Marine Corps. He now looks back on this as "Heaven-sent". He got away from the daily abuse and became a proud Marine.

When we asked Richard about low points in his life, he told us about the years he spent in prison. While this time was rough, it was also a turning point in Richard's life. "I ran from everything until I went to prison... When I got there I had to stand up and face thing. I started getting help."

Richard made the most of the time he spent incarcerated – at age 59 he earned his high school diploma and a degree in custodial maintenance. When he was released from prison, he found his way to EUMA's Liberty House for transitional housing.

Richard recalls, "I lit up when I walked in [Liberty House]. There's a great group of guys there... not afraid to sit down and talk... and Libby (the resident cat) is good company too!"

When the position of Facilities Manager became available at EUMA – the Director of Veteran Services thought of Richard because he was always fixing things and doing work around Liberty House. Richard took the position in August of 2020 and is a perfect fit.

Richard shared so many struggles – we asked if he could think of a high point in his journey – and he said, "Right now – working here... this job means the world to me."


When we asked Richard what he would say to donors—he said "I just want to thank them — I don't know where I'd be without them or EUMA".

# Why does EUMA Exist: A brief explanation

EUMA exists to be a Christ-centered community, commited to ending homelessness in the Northwestern Pennsylvania region.

The United States Interagency Council on Homelessness states that an end to homelessness means that every community will have a comprehensive response in place that ensures homelessness is prevented whenever possible, or if it can't be prevented, it is a rare, brief, and one-time experience.

There are 348 people homeless in Erie County on any given night. On average, 6 of those people are unsheltered.
